Dear Parents and Carers,

You may have seen on our Facebook page recently that Baildon Glen has been chosen as a school to trial the Labour Government's new 'Universal Free Breakfast Club' initiative. We are delighted that we have been chosen as we will be helping to shape policy and provision in other schools across the country.

The government is funding school to give children and families 30 minutes of free before-school childcare provision which includes a healthy breakfast. This will ensure that all children have a healthy start to their day and mean that they are ready to learn.

Our new universal free breakfast club will start after Easter and will run from 8.15-8.45am. If you choose to take advantage of this fabulous provision, your child will be given toast, cereal, yogurt, juice and fruit for their breakfast and will go to class at 8.45am. Children will need to be dropped off at the kitchen door rather than their classroom door at 8.15am and will be provided with breakfast and activities in the dinner hall.

If you don't wish to send your child to the breakfast club, classroom doors will be open from **8.40am rather than 8.30am**, with lessons starting at 8.45am. Yogurt and fruit will still be available for children arriving straight to the classrooms.
